Grading Policy

- District-Wide Unit Tests/Classroom Tests/Projects: 60%
 - Each major unit will culminate in a test. There will be several each quarter and all will be announced ahead of time.
 - Projects will also be assigned throughout the year. Each will be graded using a specific rubric and will be weighted as a test grade.
- Quizzes/ Writing Assignments/ Classwork: 30%
 - o Quizzes will be given periodically throughout each quarter.
- Homework: 10%
 - o Homework will be assigned periodically throughout each quarter.
 - Homework is given to help reinforce new material and is important for class discussions. It will always be checked.
 - o Homework will be posted in a designated area in the classroom. You will have time to copy down the homework into your agenda at the beginning of each class period. Homework will also be posted on the class website.
 - Some assignments may be handed in a day late for half-credit, otherwise it is a zero.

Attendance and Make-Up Work

- Please make every effort to attend class every day; however, if you are absent, **you** are responsible for finding out and making up any work missed while you were out. All worksheets, packets, etc. will be placed in a designated area in the classroom where you will be able to retrieve them upon your return.
